Program Purpose & Funding









- •Expand the reach of Zero Waste events throughout Washtenaw County; including education and ordinance efforts
- •\$19,500 Pollution Prevention Grant from the State of Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ)
 - Funding from August 2015- August 2017
 - Existing program staff, funds, partnerships, and supplies

Program Highlights

- •Average diversion rate per event was 89% over 40 events
- •6.4 tons of waste was diverted from the landfill
- •62,000 attendees were reached
 - •Largest event had 18,000 attendees
- •Discussions began about creating a **Zero Waste event ordinance** for Ann Arbor



- •Developed an outreach and advertising campaign
- •Created a "toolkit" for other communities to use

Program Challenges

- Volunteer recruitment
 - •Education of all attendees
- •Food vendor and exhibitor compliance with guidelines
 - Purchasing compostable and recyclable packaging
- Expanding to other areas
 - •Viewing "zero waste" as achievable
- Program recognition at events
